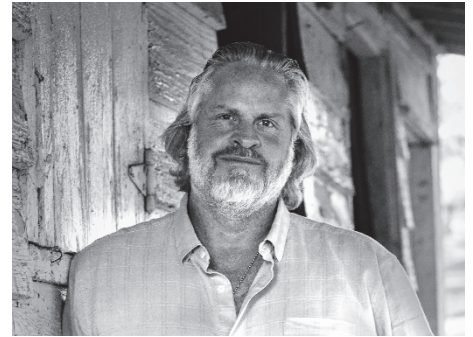


Messianic Prophecy, Fulfillment Advent Inserts

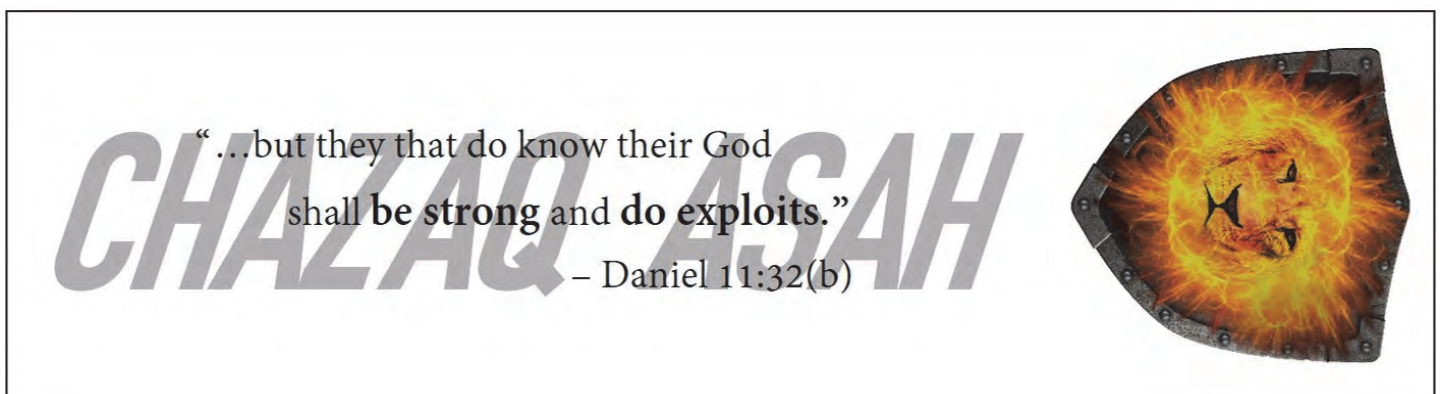

Advent Prophecy & Fulfillment Inserts

Dec. 1 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." – Galatians 3:8

You are the sons of the prophets and of the covenant that God made with your fathers, saying to Abraham, 'And in your offspring shall all the families of the earth be blessed.' God, having raised up his servant, sent him to you first, to bless you by turning every one of you from your wickedness. – Acts 3:25-26

Dec. 3 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.

– 1 Corinthians 5:7

Dec. 5 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus... – Romans 3:23-24

But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. – 1 John 1:7

Dec. 2 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

...but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. – Romans 5:8

Dec. 4 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

So the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first, and of the other who had been crucified with him. But when they came to Jesus and saw that he was already dead, they did not break his legs. For these things took place that the Scripture might be fulfilled: "Not one of his bones will be broken."

– John 19:32,33,36

Dec. 6 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

[Jesus said,] "And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him." – John 3:14-17

Dec. 7 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. – John 1:1,14

But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law... – Galatians 4:4

Dec. 8 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

So Jesus said to them, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me. And he who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to him." – John 8:28-29

Dec. 2 Prophecy ≈1350 B.C.

— *The blood of the Lamb saves from wrath.* —

The blood shall be a sign for you, on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you, when I strike the land of Egypt. – Exodus 12:13

Dec. 4 Prophecy ≈1350 B.C.

— *Not a bone of the Lamb to be broken.* —

It shall be eaten in one house; you shall not take any of the flesh outside the house, and you shall not break any of its bones.
– Exodus 12:46

Dec. 6 Prophecy ≈1300 B.C.

— *The Lamb takes on sin; lifted up on a pole.* —

So Moses made a bronze serpent and set it on a pole. And if a serpent bit anyone, he would look at the bronze serpent and live.
– Numbers 21:9

Dec. 7 Prophecy ≈1300 B.C.

— *I shall see Him, but not now.* —

I see him, but not now;
I behold him, but not near:
a star shall come out of Jacob,
and a scepter shall rise out of Israel;
it shall crush the head of Moab
and break down all the sons of Sheth.
– Numbers 24:17

Dec. 8 Prophecy ≈1300 B.C.

— *Messiah sent by The Lord to speak His word.* —

I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him.
– Deuteronomy 18:18

Dec. 1 Prophecy ≈1800 B.C.

— *The seed of Abraham will bless all nations.* —

[The Lord said to Abraham,] “I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”
– Genesis 12:3

Dec. 3 Prophecy ≈1350 B.C.

— *Jesus Christ is our Passover.* —

Then Moses called all the elders of Israel and said to them, “Go and select lambs for yourselves...and kill the Passover lamb...touch the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that is in the basin. For (when) the Lord...sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, (He) will pass over the door and will not allow the destroyer to enter your houses to strike you. You shall observe this rite...for you and for your sons forever. And when your children say to you, ‘What do you mean by this service?’ you shall say, ‘It is the sacrifice of the Lord's Passover, for he passed over the houses of the people of Israel...’” And the people bowed their heads and worshiped.

Dec. 5 Prophecy ≈1300 B.C.

— *His blood makes atonement.* —

<i>Dec. 9</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D.</i>
<p>For it was fitting that [Jesus], for whom and by whom all things exist, in bringing many sons to glory, should make [Himself,] the founder of their salvation perfect through suffering. – Hebrews 2:10</p>		

<i>Dec. 11</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D.</i>
<p>...the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham...Abraham was the father of Isaac, and Isaac the father of Jacob, and Jacob the father of Judah and his brothers... He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David... – Matthew 1:1-2 Luke 1:32</p>		

<i>Dec. 13</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D. 2021+ A.D.</i>
<p>...“Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him.” ...and behold, a voice from heaven said, “This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.” the holy one, the true one, who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens...From his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, and he will rule them with a rod of iron. He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty. – Matthew 2:2; 3:17 Rev. 2:7, 19:15</p>		

<i>Dec. 15</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D.</i>
<p>And those who passed by derided him, wagging their heads and saying, “You who would destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save yourself! If you are the Son of God, come down from the cross.” So also the chief priests, with the scribes and elders, mocked him, saying, “He saved others; he cannot save himself. He is the King of Israel; let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. He trusts in God; let God deliver him now, if he desires him. For he said, ‘I am the Son of God.’” – Matthew 27:39-43</p>		

<i>Dec. 10</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D.</i>
<p>Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world...He predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will...In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace... – Ephesians 1:3-5,7</p>		

<i>Dec. 12</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D. 2021+ A.D.</i>
<p>Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life...an hour is coming, and is now here, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live...and come out, those who have done good to the resurrection of life... ...and behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth come to judge and make war. – John 5:24-29 Revelation 19:11</p>		

<i>Dec. 14</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D.</i>
<p>And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?” that is, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?” – Matthew 27:46</p> <p>For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. – 2 Corinthians 5:21</p>		

Dec. 10 Prophecy ≈1150 B.C.

— *Messiah our Kinsman Redeemer.* —

...the redeemer said, "Take my right of redemption yourself, for I cannot redeem it." Boaz said..."You are witnesses this day that I have bought from the hand of Naomi (her inheritance;) Also Ruth the Moabite, the widow of Mahlon, I have bought to be my wife...So Boaz took Ruth, and she became his wife...the Lord gave her conception, and she bore a son...Then the women said to Naomi, "Blessed be the Lord, who has not left you this day without a redeemer, and may his name be renowned in Israel! He shall be to you a restorer of life..." (The child) was the father of Jesse, the father of David. – Ruth 4 selections

Dec. 12 Prophecy ≈1600? B.C.

— *Restoration of the righteous;* —
 — *return of the Risen King.* —

As for me, I know that my Redeemer lives;
 And He shall stand at last on the earth;
 And after my skin is destroyed, this I know:
 That in my flesh I shall see God;
 Whom I shall see for myself;
 And my eyes shall behold, and not another.
 O how my heart yearns within me! – Job 19:25-27

Dec. 14 Prophecy ≈1000 B.C.

— *Forsaken for the sins of others.* —

My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?
 Why are you so far from saving me, from the words
 of my groaning?
 – Psalm 22:1

Dec. 9 Prophecy ≈1250 B.C.

— *Captain of our salvation.* —

...Joshua...lifted up his eyes...and behold, a man was standing before him with his drawn sword in his hand. And Joshua...said to him, "Are you for us, or for our adversaries?" And he said, "Neither; I am the commander of the army of the Lord. Now I have come." And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshiped and said to him, "What does my Lord say to his servant?" – Joshua 5:13-14

Dec. 11 Prophecy ≈1000 B.C.

— *David's seed the Son of God;* —
 — *everlasting kingdom.* —

"...I will raise up your offspring after you...and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son...And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever." – 2 Samuel 7:12-14,16

Dec. 13 Prophecy ≈1000 B.C.

— *Christ begotten; Messiah is come;* —
 — *omnipotent reign.* —

"As for me, I have set my King
 on Zion, my holy hill."
 I will tell of the decree:
 The Lord said to me, "You are my Son;
 today I have begotten you.
 You shall break them with a rod of iron
 and dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel."

Dec. 15 Prophecy ≈1000 B.C.

— *Scorned at His sacrifice by the wicked.* —

All who see me mock me;
 they make mouths at me; they wag their heads;
 "He trusts in the Lord; let him deliver him;
 let him rescue him, for he delights in him!"

<i>Dec. 16</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D.</i>
	<p>...Someone ran and filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on a reed and gave it to him to drink, saying, "Wait, let us see whether Elijah will come to take him down." And Jesus uttered a loud cry and breathed his last. ...one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear, and at once there came out blood and water...Pilate gave [Joseph of Arimathea] permission. So he came and took away his body. Then [the resurrected Jesus] said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe." – Mark 15:36,37 John 19:34,38 John 20:27</p>	

<i>Dec. 17</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D.</i>
	<p>If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you... But all these things they will do to you on account of my name, because they do not know him who sent me. Whoever hates me hates my Father also. If I had not done among them the works that no one else did, they would not be guilty of sin, but now they have seen and hated both me and my Father. But the word that is written in their Law must be fulfilled: 'They hated me without a cause.' Now the chief priests and the whole council were seeking false testimony against Jesus that they might put him to death... – Matthew 26:20-21,23-25 Matthew 26:59</p>	

<i>Dec. 18</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D.</i>
	<p>...when Jesus knew that his hour had come...when the devil had already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him, Jesus...began to wash the disciples' feet... "You [Peter] are clean, but not every one of you...But the Scripture will be fulfilled, 'He who ate my bread has lifted his heel against me.' I am telling you this now, before it takes place, that when it does take place you may believe that I am He...Truly, truly, I say to you, one of you will betray me." ...when he had dipped the morsel, he gave it to Judas Iscariot... Then after he had taken the morsel, Satan entered into him. – John 13 selections</p>	

<i>Dec. 19</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈30 A.D.</i>
	<p>Jesus said to [the Pharisees], "Have you never read in the Scriptures: 'The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone...' "Therefore I tell you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people producing its fruits. And the one who falls on this stone will be broken to pieces..." Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said [to the Pharisees,] "This Jesus [you crucified] is the stone that was rejected by you, the builders, which has become the cornerstone. And there is salvation in no one else..." [Peter to the early church,] As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious...you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood...they stumble because they disobey the Word, as they were destined to do... – Matthew 21:42-43 Acts 4:8,11-12 1 Peter 2:4-5,8</p>	

<i>Dec. 20</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈3 B.C.</i>
	<p>And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God." – Luke 1:35</p> <p>Mary was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. And her husband Joseph...resolved to divorce her quietly... Behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." – Matthew 1:18-20</p>	

Dec. 17 Prophecy ≈1000 B.C.

— False witnesses; hated without a cause. —

Malicious witnesses rise up;
they ask me of things that I do not know.
Let not those rejoice over me
who are wrongfully my foes,
and let not those wink the eye

Dec. 16 Prophecy ≈1000 B.C.

— Utter ruination at the Messiah's crucifixion. —

I am poured out like water,
and all my bones are out of joint;
my heart is like wax;
it is melted within my breast;
my strength is dried up like a potsherd,
and my tongue sticks to my jaws;
you lay me in the dust of death.
For dogs encompass me;
a company of evildoers encircles me;

Dec. 19 Prophecy ≈1000 B.C.; 720 B.C.

— Rejected stone became the chief cornerstone. —

The stone that the builders rejected

offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be

Dec. 18 Prophecy ≈1000 B.C.

— Betrayed by a friend. —

Even my close friend in whom I trusted,
who ate my bread, has lifted his heel against me.
For it is not an enemy who taunts me—
then I could bear it;
it is not an adversary who deals insolently with me—
then I could hide from him.
But it is you, a man, my equal,
my companion, my familiar friend.
We used to take sweet counsel together;
within God's house we walked in the throng.

Dec. 20 Prophecy ≈720 B.C.

— Messiah born of a virgin; named Emmanuel. —

Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold,
the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call
his name Immanuel.
— Isaiah 7:14

Dec. 21 *Fulfillment* *≈3 B.C.*

And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David... | And all spoke well of him and marveled at the gracious words that were coming from his mouth. And they said, "Is not this Joseph's son?" | [Jesus said,] "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." | [God's] Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh and was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord...

Dec. 23 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

And taking the twelve, [Jesus] said to them, "See, we are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written about the Son of Man by the prophets will be accomplished. For he will be delivered over to the Gentiles and will be mocked and shamefully treated and spit upon. And after flogging him, they will kill him, and on the third day he will rise." But they understood none of these things. This saying was hidden from them, and they did not grasp what was said.
– Luke 18:31-34

Then they spit in his face and struck him. And some slapped him, saying, "Prophecy to us, you Christ! Who is it that struck you?"

Dec. 22 *Fulfillment* *≈3 B.C.*

[A righteous man Simeon] took [young Jesus] up in his arms and blessed God and said,
"Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace,
 according to your word;
for my eyes have seen your salvation
 that you have prepared in the presence of all
peoples,
a light for revelation to the Gentiles,
 and for glory to your people Israel."
– Luke 2:28-32

Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."
– John 8:12

Repent therefore, that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send [Jesus] Christ appointed for you...[at] the time of restoration of all things...

Dec. 24 *Fulfillment* *≈30 A.D.*

Though he had done so many signs before them, they still did not believe in him, so that the word spoken by the prophet Isaiah might be fulfilled... – John 12:37-38

...though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself...by taking the form of a servant, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. – Philippians 2:6-8

When they heard these things, all in the synagogue were filled with wrath. And they rose up and drove him out of the town and brought him to the brow of the hill...so that they could throw him down the cliff.
– Luke 4:28-29

Pilate said to them, "Then what shall I do with Jesus who is called Christ?" They all said, "Let him be crucified!" And he said, "Why? What evil has he done?" But they shouted all the more, "**LET HIM BE CRUCIFIED!**" – Matthew 27:22-23

[The Lord] says: “It is too light a thing that you should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to bring back the preserved of Israel; I will make you as a light for the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth.” — Isaiah 49:6		

<i>Dec. 21</i>	<i>Prophecy</i>	<i>≈720 B.C.</i>
— A Son is given; established in power. —		
For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. — Isaiah 9:6		

<i>Dec. 23</i>	<i>Prophecy</i>	<i>≈720 B.C.</i>
— Messiah shockingly abused; — — His blood will bring salvation to the nations. —		
As many were astonished at you— his appearance was so marred, beyond human semblance, and his form beyond that of the children of mankind— so shall he sprinkle many nations. Kings shall shut their mouths because of him, for that which has not been told them they see, and that which they have not heard they understand. — Isaiah 52:14-15		

<i>Dec. 24</i>	<i>Prophecy</i>	<i>≈720 B.C.</i>
— Meshiach ben Joseph, the suffering Messiah. —		
Who has believed what he has heard from us? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? For he grew up before him like a young plant, and like a root out of dry ground; he had no form or majesty that we should look at him, and no beauty that we should desire him. He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and by his wounds we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all. — Isaiah 53:1-6		

<i>Dec. 25</i>	<i>Fulfillment</i>	<i>≈3 B.C.</i>
	<p>And behold, wise men from the east came to Jerusalem, saying, "Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him." ...assembling all the chief priests and scribes of the people, [King Herod] inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They told him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for so it is written by the prophet [Isaiah]:</p> <p>'And you, O Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for from you shall come a ruler who will shepherd my people Israel.'"</p> <p>– Matthew 2:2,4-6</p>	
	<p>And behold, the star that [the wise men] had seen when it rose went before them until it came to rest over the place where the child was. When they saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly with great joy. And going into the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him.
